

(22:14) "...For a harlot is a deep pit, and a seductress is a narrow well. She also lies in wait as for a victim, and increases the unfaithful among men." (23:26)

"For by means of a harlot a man is reduced to a crust of bread; and an adulteress will prey upon his precious life. Can a man take fire to his bosom, and his clothes not be burned? Can one walk on hot coals, and his feet not be seared? So is he who goes in to his neighbour's wife; whoever touches her shall not be innocent ... Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks understanding; he who does so destroys his own soul." (Proverbs 6:23, 32)

Many men and women have been horribly burned by other predatory "lovers" who were just playing them for the sex they were able to give them. Once these types of players start to tire and bore of you (and they will tire of you), they will then trade you in for their next new conquest, and you will be left with either broken hopes and dreams if you are not married, or your own marriage will be left in a state of total shambles if you were doing this as an adulterous affair behind your spouse's back.

**Parties:** The environment that is most conducive to illicit sex is the party one. Parties and its after-effects on society are so damaging it's a wonder how it has not been outlawed. Did Jesus, Muhammad (p) give their blessings to "parties"? This is a social invention of godless people. Testimony to the degraded nature of our thinking. The office party has become an institutionalized occasion for lust. As the girls sway your eyes seek out the most sensual. Drinking in her movements which are a simulation of sex. Alcoholic drinks cause license to rule & dignity to evaporate. Brains become befuddled, souls burn & hearts are restless. In that corner a man reveals the secrets of his love for a girl, proud of her exposed beauty. Over there a young man arranges sweet words & subtle hints in his mind as he prepares to talk to a beautiful girl, dressed more in skin than clothing. An old man asks for songs that remind him of his frivolous youth, with his heart breaking as he eyes the young maidens. Look a woman winks at a man, beckoning to him, but he looks with lust at another. A wife whose husband is drunk finds a chance to sell her favours to her adulterous lover. Men leverage for a glimpse of exposed cleavage. All are drowning in a sea of sinful flirtations. Marilyn Monroe, America's party queen & sex goddess (what an obnoxious title) said: **"I hate every man that slept with me."** Realization that came too late. Elvis Presley,

America's party king, was totally confused as to the meaning of life. Used to visit the morgue seeking life in death. Both committed suicide. A pity. But even more mysterious is the fact that they are both portrayed as role models. Figure out your motives as you plan for that party. A few careless moments is all it takes to cause a lifetime of regrets. Regrets cannot be cured by prescription drugs. Regrets destroy body and soul.

Gia had it, whatever "it" is. One of the world's top models at 19. She appeared on scores of glitzy front covers from Vogue to Cosmopolitan. Roamed in France, Italy, Morocco & the Caribbean. Lived in the speedy lane of high fashion & the highwire nightlife at Studio 54. First came cocaine, then heroin, and finally AIDS. She died in 1986 at the age of 26. She struggled with her mother & despite many sexual liaisons, she **never** found love. Wild, loose sex never brings true joy and satisfaction. Do not be fooled by soap operas and ads. Besides leading to an early grave, take heed of eternal damnation, couched in the commandment "Thou shall **not** commit adultery."

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus equated lust to ADULTERY!: "But I tell you that anyone who looks at someone lustfully has already committed ADULTERY with them in their heart." So the "key does **not** have to enter the keyhole"...it starts with the lustful look. **More adultery is committed before the TV & computer monitor than anywhere else!**

Sexual temptations dominate. The cure is spiritual knowledge. The Prophet's warning: "Avoid adultery/fornication, for it has six effects; of these, three are experienced in this world and the other three in the Hereafter." # Adultery

No joy...just hurtful consequences

"When our civilization is indeed tottering on the verge of collapse we see that in fact the last decades have been marked by a choice of license for both sexes **RATHER** than discipline.

The result has been an enormous waste of creative power. Pornography, prostitution, fornication & adultery, combined with the prevention of conception ...represent to us the unwholesome swamp into which the water of energy have flowed. The sin of adultery is **not** so much about the sex, it is the deceit and lies which must be told to perpetuate it and that is the real damage. To look at your spouse with a straight face and say you are going shopping while meeting someone in a hotel is so unnerving and hurtful. **DECEIT...** A double life is exhausting. The weight of carrying on that deception is unbearable. **Working Late, huh?**

## Beware

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**A**dultery/fornication, sexual engagements that dominate movies/magazines/music videos/the Net. The problems that it spawns are beyond repair but yet it is glamorized. Most societies have been so desensitized by *hellivision* that adultery has become an accepted thing in society. Gene Simmons of the perverted rock band Kiss brags that he has had sex with over 4,600 women in his devilish career. Such women/girls sleeping with a “star” are just plain stupid. “Star?” How bright do you have to be to write songs about having sex, getting drunk and partying?

You probably won't hear many sermons about adultery, and it is easy to understand why. The preacher is either “preaching to the choir,” or preaching to people who don't want to be reminded of their sins.

Sex is natural. It touches us all and we have made rather a mess of it! We want to know why, and we want to do better. We are beginning to understand that this instinct of sex which has been so great a cause of suffering and shame and has been treated as a subject fit only for furtive whispers or silly jokes, is in fact one of the greatest powers in human nature, and that its misuse is indeed “the expense of spirit in a waste of shame.” Sex is not a dirty thing. It can only be realized by remembering that the corruption of the best is the worst, and that we can measure by the hideousness of debased and depraved sexuality, the greatness and the wonder of God's legal sex love.

We live in an adulterous age. We live in an age when promises and faithfulness, the hard work of fidelity, to values, to the moral life, seem secondary to the drive to attain fleeting scraps of pleasure. The consequences of adultery, to the so-called lovers, or to those born from the union, are often disastrous. From the Bible & Quran to the works of Shakespeare and Tolstoy, there is a consistent warning against this particular form of deception...a deception that plays with the deepest, most intimate connections of humankind. Adulterers are thrust into a life of deceit. Children born of the affairs, grow up with feelings of rejection and inadequacy. Lies, as any affair goes on, pile one on top of the other. It is morally corrosive.

Illicit sex always offer the promise of excitement, maybe even of fulfillment, and holds out

the possibility of satisfaction in unsatisfactory lives. Our urges can overpower our mind and our heart. We are unsteady, tipped off balance. We act impulsively, throwing us at first into a frenzy of excitement and then into a free fall until the object of desire becomes tawdry, stale and even repugnant. It is not what we want after all, not what we are really seeking. The lover will be found not to be *that hot* but Hell is *that hot*. The allure of adultery is that it kindles passions that routine and familiarity can leave blunted. This allure is the staple of the advertising and entertainment industries. Two exceedingly evil industries. It is fed to us in a steady stream that flows into our computer monitors, TV sets, looks out at us from glossy magazine pages and billboards. It is the deep destructive power of illicit sexual attraction.

Payment for such a favour is sinful. Deviant. But there are other ways down this slippery path.

A man, suddenly at mid-life, realizes the futility of his “busy” life. He is at a loss to make a change. He does not know anything else. Lonely and depressed, he is especially vulnerable. It's not hard to imagine what happens next. He becomes friendly with a neighbour, “friend” or someone with a sympathetic ear. Or an estranged wife! Her inner emptiness mirrors his own, and, almost without realizing it, an emotional bond is formed. For the first time in longer than he can remember, he feels “alive.” Here's a woman who appreciates him as a man, as a person. She listens to him and really cares about the things he's feeling.

At this point he probably would be shocked if someone suggested he was well on his way to having an affair. He's never allowed that thought to enter his mind – well, almost never. Dr. Carlfred Broderick: “I am convinced that more people get themselves into the pain of infidelity through empathy, concern and compassion than through any base motive. The world is full of lonely and vulnerable people, hungry for a sympathetic ear and a shoulder to cry on. With a little help from rationalization, the sympathy leads smoothly into tenderness, the tenderness to the need for privacy, the privacy to physical consolation, and the consolation straight to bed.”

The need for emotional intimacy is one of the greatest reasons for the affair. Affairs begin not just for sexual reasons but to satisfy the basic need we all have for closeness, goodness, kindness, togetherness. When these needs are not met on a regular basis in a marriage, the motivation may be to find a person who will be good to us,

touch us, hold us, give us a feeling of closeness. Sexual fulfillment may indeed become an important part of an extramarital relationship, but the closeness needs are initially more important.

It is way too EASY to get snared by the Internet and the beckoning chat forums & Face-Crook social cheatworks. *Facebook Infidelity Almost Triples Sales of Digital Surveillance Tools*. The reason for this **huge increase** in the demand of digital spying software indicates that married couples believe that their partners are involved in digital infidelity. Psychologists believe that one of the primary causes of this fear and insecurity is Facebook. The social networking giant has opened up avenues of digital/emotional cheating that were unimaginable a few years back. Online affairs always start as friendships. They change when you begin to share marital problems with each other (as is apt to happen). It's easy to become vulnerable to another person coming in and telling you what you want to hear ... replacing them for your spouse as your friend. Even if you never physically see each other during the period the “chats” take place it is adultery. A marriage is built on trust, honesty, the real action of love, and mutual respect. All of these things are **violated in secret chats**.

When we sacrifice “family” for other things we are setting ourselves up for some devastating losses in our personal lives. Even if we never have an affair or we have one but our spouse never finds out, we are still the losers. Most marriages that fail never end up in the divorce court. What good is a family if you're not a “family”? Marriage requires time and tenderness, communication and closeness. Are you living the kind of life that will leave you fulfilled when you near the end of your earthly existence? No one has ever said on their deathbed: “I wish I had spent more time on my business.” Are you investing time, love and energy in your spouse and your children? Do they get priority time or just the scraps you have left after giving your “best” in the marketplace? Then if such is your scenario be prepared that your spouse's needs will drift.
